Wai 1073 umbrellad by WAI 1738 is a claim
lodged for and on behalf of ALL DESCENDENTS
of Te Kere and the Upper Whanganui Hapu
of Rangitira.

WAI 1073 claim has previously been lodged in
the Whanganui, Tongariro National Park, Te Urewera
Tapu nga korero tuku iho and the Te Rōhe Potae
e Maniapoto District Inquiries.

While WAI 1073 claim continues to progress our
our Treaty interests in this inquiry, we acknowledge
and support Treaty claims lodged by

Te Ahi Awa, Ngati Raukawa and Ngati Toa
against the Crown's actions.

Te Kere said "I belong to Rangitikei".
Te Kere and Upper Whanganui hapu
came from Upper Whanganui to
Manawatu ki Porirua to assert their
Treaty Rights "te Tino Rangatiratanga"
over their Lands and Estates, Forests,
Fisheries and other Properties possessed
collectively and individually by them.

We the descendants have come to this/these
district inquiries to Lodge, Progress
and Settle the Full extent of our
Treaty claims against the Crown.

We look forward to further participation
in this inquiry
